PLACES COVERED

- AMBOLI HILLS: Tucked away in the Sahyadri range, Amboli is a mist-covered hill station bursting with waterfalls, dense forests, and rare wildlife. It's one of the best spots to witness monsoon magic and go on thrilling night herping trails to spot species like the Malabar Pit Viper and Dancing Frog.
- VENGURLA: A peaceful coastal town known for its clean beaches, old temples, and vibrant local markets. Vengurla offers a beautiful blend of heritage and sea breeze, perfect for exploring local produce, spices, and the charm of slow coastal life.
- SINDHUDURG: Named after the historic sea fort built by Shivaji Maharaj, Sindhudurg is a gem on the Konkan coast. From tropical forests and waterfalls to quiet beaches and cultural richness, it's a gateway to authentic Konkani life during the monsoon.
- MALVAN: Famous for its seafood, water sports, and the iconic Malvani cuisine, Malvan is a coastal town where the culture is as vibrant as the scenery. During monsoons, the lush surroundings and warm hospitality make it a perfect spot to unwind by the shore.
